Pavilion

The Sports Association has had the complete alarm system serviced which ensures that the whole building, including the garage, is protected from a potential break in.

The disabled toilet alarm system is defective and has become inoperative. Whilst the Sports Association had engineered financially the provision of three new contact switches for the hot water system, the mains electrical systems board is being adjusted to incorporate this new eco-friendly arrangement. During this visit the electrician is able to remove and replace the defective disabled alarm system in the main room adjoining the extension. The cost of this is £150 and the Sports Association will be requesting this figure from the Parish Council as landlords of the building. To clarify, this is the cost of replacing the defective disabled alarm system and not the cost of the three new heater switches which will be borne through Sports Association finance.
