On Tuesday 16th January 2024 PC Maybank and members of Neighbourhood Task Force conducted speed checks along Borden Lane, Borden. In an hour period 71 vehicles were speed checked. Of these 71 vehicles, 7 were travelling 31mph – 35mph, falling under the speed we'd consider prosecuting at as it allows for 10% difference between a vehicle speedometer and the speed gun we use. We then allow an extra 2mph, hence the expression most have heard of 10% +2. Anything above 35mphwould get stopped. These vehicle details have all been taken and they will receive warning letters. Moving forward I have asked our Special Constabulary to assist by carrying out speed checks and I am hoping it will become a deterrent to speeding. Please feel free to advertise the fact we will be carrying out random speed checks.
