Information on a Parish Meeting

All Parish Councils throughout England are required by law to hold an Annual Parish Meeting, which must take place between 1st March and the 1st of June.

The meeting enables the Parish Council and local groups to explain what they have been doing over the last year and provides an opportunity for the electors to have their say on anything they consider important to the people of the Parish.

The Annual Parish Meeting is a meeting of all the local government electors for the Parish, any elector may make suggestions and comment on anything relevant to the residents of Borden.

Please note that the Annual Parish Meeting is not a Parish Council meeting.

Parish electorates are invited to attend, and it would be helpful to let the Parish Clerk know if you wish to present a report on a topic of interest or your group's activities clerk@bordenparishcouncil.gov.uk.
