

## BORDEN PARISH HALL REPORT OCTOBER 2023

1. The gents' toilets are now refurbished. We are now awaiting a date for the disabled toilet to also be refurbished. I had to call the contractor about the new toilet seats which need to be fitted more securely. Still awaiting repair;
2. The three hall heaters have been serviced by Vulcana, and a certificate has been obtained. They have also issued a gas safety document;
3. Chubb have inspected the fire extinguishers and fire blanket, and they have also issued a certificate;
4. Whilst I was away on holiday a gas leak was reported to me, and urgent arrangements were made to call out the gas emergency service. They attended and isolated the gas supply, and advised that we had to use a commercial gas contractor to repair the fault. Fortunately, I had internet whilst in the caravan, and was able to locate a commercial gas company that visited the hall and repaired the internal gas valve;
5. Comments have been made about the amount of weeds which are growing in the car park and surrounding the hall. In the past the clearance and spraying used to be arranged by the Parish Council. This needs to be considered to improve the visual impact of the hall.
