BORDEN PARISH COUNCIL PRECEPT 2023 / 2024



At Borden Parish Council's meeting held on the 19th January 2023 it was agreed to request a Precept of £70,052.40 for 2023/2024. This represents an increase of 9.48%, on the Precept that Borden Parish Council requested for 2022/2023.

This in real terms this means that residents will see an increase on 2022/2023 Precept of 11p per week for a Band D household, on their council tax bills. For a Band D household in 2022/23 it was £1.12, for 2023/24 it will be £1.23 per week.

The Parish Council do not receive any direct funding from central government and rely on the Precept plus any other income such as grants to continue to support local facilities and activities enjoyed by our parishioners, including the Playstool recreation area, Centenary gardens, Playstool woodland area, nature reserve, sports pavilion, footpath lighting, highways improvement and events.
