What's going on in your area

- Speed checks were conducted throughout Swale as part of a day of action on 15/08/2025. These checks covered Bobbing, Bredgar, Rodmersham and Borden. PC Clemmens hired the help from officers PC 30702 DIVERS and PC 31306 RADFORD who spent 45 minutes on Borden Lane enforcing the 30MPH speed limit. During this time only one driver was identified as breaking this speed limit and was suitably reprimanded which was overall a good result for public safety. We also received some positive public feedback whilst conducting the checks.
- The ward has been taken over by PC Marie Roostan. Like PC Clemmens she works a shift pattern which means she may not always be able to attend the planned council meetings due to rest days but is happy to be contacted via the parish clerk with any issues.
- In the Summer 2025 a survey was sent to all members of Borden signed up to my community voice asking what the top 3 concerns were for residents.
